WHY ALICE IN WONDERLAND?

We believe that a learning context must be a challenging environment. It has to give imput, stimulate creativity and fantasy to the learners; making them able to be concrete, but also to dream.

We want to put learners in a safe context, out of the reality, where they can learn with their time, their methods and the awareness to be able to reach every goal, regardless of their starting condition.

It doens't have to be a "formal" learning context because it should make them able to get an active role in their learning process.

CEIPES believe in the potentiality of non formal education, that's why our I-LAB is far for any kind of formal education context.







WHY THE DEVELOPMENT OF AN I-LAB IS IMPORTANT FOR NGOs THAT WORK WITH SPECIAL EDUCATION NEEDS?







BENEFITS FOR NGOs STAFF USING I-LAB SUPPORTING SEN AND INCLUSION

- Reduces isolation for trainers and professionals working in special educational needs by enabling them to communicate electronically with colleagues
- Supports reflection on professional practice face to face and via online communication
- Improved skills for staff and a greater understanding of access technology used by student and trainees
- Enhances professional development and the effectiveness of the use of ICT with trainees through collaboration with peers
- Materials already in electronic form (for example, from the internet) are more easily adapted into accessible resources such as large print.







Benefits for students / trainees / learners

- Computers can improve independent access for learners to education. This is one of the main aim of European Commission education strategy 2014/2020
- Learners with special educational needs are able to accomplish tasks working at their own place
- Learners with profound and multiple learning difficulties can communicate more easily
- Learners can use this technology to give imput also in anonymus status, preserving their privacy.







HOW AND IN WHICH FIELDS AN NGO CAN USE I-LAB?







YOUTH WORK: Training and workshops



The specific context of I-LAB make an environment suitable and confortable to work with different kind of target group even with special education needs.

The use of non formal education methods, togheter with an Inspirational and fairy-tale environment, helps to put all the trainees and the facilitators in the same level and in a different state of mind: it can be made a small learning community inside this context

Workshop: "leader in your community", about active citizenship, project management and development of inclusive strategy for the community.

ACTIVITIES WITH YOUTH WORKERS AND YOUNG EDUCATORS:

I-LAB supports the work in the capacity buliding process of youngsters with attitude to work in educational and social field.

It can be a tool to support the learning of volunteers (including EVS volunteers), students and staff.

Moreover its features make it a perfect context for the carring out of activities with NON FORMAL EDUCATION methods.







IMPLEMENTATION OF TEAM WORK



I-LAB can be used by an NGO to all kind of team work related taskes:

- CEIPES is using it for its transnational meeting for enforcing the cooperation with partnership
- CEIPES is using it for staff meeting and staff training session. The environment of I-LAB let staff members "break" with the "working environment" putting them in a more relaxing and creative context, perfect for learning activity.







I-LAB IN VET EDUCATION

As CEIPES Scenario showed, I-LAB can be a tool for improving the communication with different professional related to special education needs or any other specific topic:

Example from CEIPES experiences:

- Psychologist: this kind of professionals can deal the same topic comparing their differents approach or theorical background of intervention strategy.
- Educators, pedagogues, psychologists, social workers, operators and volunteers can improve their cooperation skills finding common strategy (inside the same organization or among several of these).
- ICT experts, trainers and trainees can use I-LAB for their learning pathways thanks to an environment in which is very easy to communicate, to work in team, to give imput and feedback to the learners and working in remote.
- Traning process for interns can be carry out easily and in a context that they cannot find in other organization.









I-LAB IN PROJECT MANAGEMENT

One of the most important skills that the staff of an NGO must have is the management of a project (writing, implementing and evaluating).



Which benefits does I-LAB bring?

- To facilitate the developments of the ideas and the proposal thanks to the brainstorming process (especially thanks to the VBS Software).
- If the project is developed by a consortium, I-LAB may supports the communication with partner or potential one.
- It decreases the intensity of the stress (because deadline, tasks, lack of ideas, lack of time, lack of words allowed, etc...) thanks to its environment.
